Furzefield Campsite



Conditions of Use

- Any use of the campsite is only by prior arrangement with the Booking Secretary, with at least 2 weeks' notice for daytime or evening use.
- The campsite is for the use of members of The Scout Association, The Guide Association and other organisations that can show proof that they have Public Liability Insurance cover. This must be attached to the Campsite Booking Form.
- Users of the campsite must always follow the rules of their organisation.
- No vehicles are allowed onto the campsite beyond the car park.
- Fires can only be lit in designated fire pits and the campfire circle, see campsite map for locations. **Do not move any bricks around the campsite.** There are logs on site available for splitting, bring your own tools. If you use wood from the log sheds, please replenish from the main woodpile near the front gate.
- Fires are not to be left unattended and must be fully extinguished before leaving. Ashes are to remain in the fire pits.
- No pallets, treated timber, chipboard, fence panels etc to be brought on site.
- All rubbish is to be removed from the site on departure. **A £30 removal fee will be charged to noncompliant users.**
- Damage to any growing shrubs, trees or barriers will not be tolerated.
- Dogs are not allowed on site, except for guide and assistance dogs.
- Smoking is **not** permitted on site.
- **Limited toilet rolls and hand soap are supplied in the toilets, but we ask that you please bring your own to replenish what you use.**
- On departure, site keys are to be returned to key safe or as directed by the Booking Secretary or Warden.
- **The whole site, including toilet blocks, is to be left in a clean state. All cooking utensils should be washed in the outdoor washing facility behind the ladies' toilets not in the toilet basins.**
- The entrance gate and all buildings must be locked when no one is on site. It is also advisable to lock the gate at night and when no one is present in the car park area.
- All types of firearms are banned from use on the site. Archery is permitted only with prior approval from the Booking Secretary.
- Allocation of camping sites is at the discretion of the Booking Secretary or Warden.
- **Failure to comply with these conditions could result in future use of the campsite being refused.** Visits can be made by the campsite warden or his representative at any time. If you are asked to leave the site, fees will not be refunded.
- Please be aware that overhead power cables run across the site.
